Meals will be provided to all children without charge and are the same for all children regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability, and there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service. Meals will be provided, on a first come, first serve basis, at the sites and times to be announced. If you or your organization have activities or events planned during this time for participants who are 18 years of age or younger, we can provide meals free of charge. We are able to provide breakfast, lunch or supper depending on the time of your activities.
