### **Opening Business**

Mr. Neace discussed the items presented in the “Good News Report.” This included KPREP praise: the 6<sup>th</sup> grade celebrated their KPREP scores at the elementary schools and the Middle school is working to create stickers for student lockers for Proficient and Distinguished.

Selah Bussell, an 8<sup>th</sup> grader, was published on the Teen Ink webpage.

A leadership committee has been meeting once a month, and discussing ways to best serve our students and focusing on student achievement.

Mrs. Reinhardt’s 8<sup>th</sup> grade advanced ELA class completed a Mock Trial based on the Outsiders. All students did a wonderful job.

Special Education Team received all their chrome books, the case to store them just came in today.

### **Student Achievement**

KPREP data was shared with teachers. Some highlights include: Achievement Points were 70.6 and the Overall Score was 62.4. Both of these data points showed an increase from the previous year.

### **Gap Closure**

The GAP points decreased, and this has become the focus of this year, and we are already seeing improvements in students’ academic performance.

Teachers and administration are working to develop a plan to push the students who were borderline into the next achievement group for next year. Administration is going to get a plan together and determine the best method to approach this issue with the students. The actual plan has not yet been decided.

### **Attendance**

An increase of attendance has shown when compared to last year. In the month of September, 6<sup>th</sup> grade had 95.28%, 7<sup>th</sup> grade had 94.71%, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade had 94.06%; with an overall of 94.69%.

Members discussed having a competition with grade levels in the cafeteria. Winner with best attendance would win a reward. Members also discussed a possible use of Google Classroom for students who miss based on medical issues. Nothing has yet to be decided.

Teacher attendance had decreased from last year, being 75 absences compared to 52 last year.
