Opening Business

The BCHS Special Called Site Based Council meeting of June 18, 2013 began at 6:00 p.m. in the school library with the following council members present: Greg Hubbard, Kim Halsey, Paul Prater and Lee Ann Ramey. Mr. Ricky Prater and Mrs. Alisha Clemons were absent.

Good News Report - Mr. Greg Hubbard commented that South Whitt (2013 BCHS graduate) was probably the first BCHS graduate to receive a full ride to an Ivy League School. Mr. Paul Prater was pleased to let everyone know BCHS would have a Reading Specialist.

Financial Report

13-070 Mrs. Kim Halsey moved to approve the May 2013 financial report. Mrs. Lee Ann Ramey provided a second and the motion passed by consensus.

Review

Vacancies - Mr. Paul Prater conducted the final consultation on current vacancies at BCHS. The positions and individuals hired are as follows:

Library Media Specialist – As reported previously, this position is itinerant therefore, hiring will be handled by the Board office. Mr. Paul Prater provided an update – interviews to be conducted this Friday and plans are to have someone hired by next week.

New Business

Reading Specialist – This is also an itinerant position. Mr. Paul Prater reported of all the applicants, only one (1) was actually qualified.

13-071 Coaching Vacancy Consultation – Mr. Paul Prater provided an update on the coaching vacancies. Another special called meeting has been scheduled for 06/25/13 to interview/consult on these vacancies. He shared with everyone that a committee had been formed by District Athletic person, Teresa Caudill, to interview candidates for these vacancies – Girls and Boys Soccer and Cheerleading Coach. He asked council members how they wanted to proceed with interviews/hiring for these vacancies.

Mrs. Lee Ann Ramey moved to have the committee formed by Mrs. Caudill to screen, interview and rank the applicants when one more than one person was interviewed. Further, if necessary Mr. Paul Prater would have the authority to re-interview applicants and final consultation with the SBDM Council would take place at the special called meeting on 06/25/13. Mr. Greg Hubbard provided a second to this motion and it passed by consensus.
