Policy Statement:

The School Based Decision Making Council of Bath County High School shall consist of the principal, three (3) teachers and two (2) parents. The teachers and parents shall be elected in compliance with KRS 160.345. Teacher and parent council members are eligible for re-election. Membership may be for consecutive years if elected to one-year terms. The term of office shall be from July 1 through June 30. No leave of absence shall be granted.

A vacancy is created when any of the following occur: (1) a teacher is no longer assigned to the school, (2) a parent no longer has a child enrolled in the school, (3) a council member misses more than 2 regularly scheduled meetings, or (4) a council member misses more than 3 special called meetings. Once a council member is removed the election process to fill the vacancy shall begin.

If an opening occurs, the person receiving the next highest votes in the original election will fill any council vacancies. In the event that another person is not available, then a new election will be conducted within thirty (30) days of the newly created vacancy following the original election process.
