NEW IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Parent/Guardian:

Please see the new immunization requirements that will take effect July 1, 2018. If your child does not have TWO Hepatitis A vaccines before this date, he/she will not be up to date on their immunizations. If your child has already had TWO doses of the Hepatitis A vaccine, we will need an updated immunization certificate sent to the school. If not, please make it a priority to schedule a doctor's appointment or an appointment at the Local Health Department for your child to get these important immunizations.

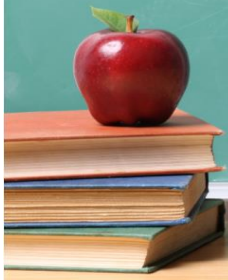
