Dear Bath County School Stakeholders,

Due to the continued increase in reported Bath County COVID-19 cases, our county has been reclassified as “red status.” According to the state of Kentucky’s COVID-19 metric system measuring the community spread of the virus, the Bath County School Board decided on October 29, 2020 to suspend hybrid instruction and switch to 100% virtual (online) instruction beginning November 2nd through November 29th.

All other school activities, athletics, school-age child care, and meal delivery will be suspended during the week of November 2nd. Each week after this time, the Board has granted the superintendent the discretion to consider allowing these activities should the Bath County COVID-19 metric decrease to either the orange, yellow, or green level.

Our teachers and staff will continue to work to ensure students have access to the technology, instruction, materials, and resources needed to make this transition successful. We would also like to extend our appreciation to you for your ongoing patience and dedication during these trying times. Our staff will continue to monitor, evaluate, and determine the best course of action regarding in-person versus virtual instruction.
