As many of you are aware, the Coronavirus has resulted in changes to normal routines. The Governor has requested that school close at this time so Pathways is taking steps to ensure a continuation of services. In order to continue to receive services you and/or your child should contact the Pathways office at 674-6690 to request an appointment. You may also e-mail me with the e-mail address provided below. If you already have an appointment scheduled in the office then those appointments will remain unchanged.

Appointments can be conducted in one of two ways. You may request an in person appointment to be held at the Bath County Pathways office (664 Slate Avenue, Owingsville) or you may request a telehealth appointment. The download link for the telehealth conferencing service called LifeSize is below. You must provide a current e-mail address when calling to schedule the telehealth appointment so that the unique conferencing link can be shared. Due to this service being made available to all Pathways students, please know an appointment may not be immediately available. Please contact us as early as possible to ensure the appointment is scheduled timely.
