Policy Statement Make-up Work
<p>Students with an excused absence must, within three days upon returning to school, make up work that has been missed or make arrangements with his/her teachers for completion dates. Failure to do so will result in the student receiving a zero for all work missed.</p> <p>The following are clarifications on make-up work:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a. Parents desiring to pick up assignments while the student is absent should call the school by 9:30 a.m. to allow teachers time to get work together. The request should not come at the end of the school day. Requested work may be picked up between 3:00 and 4:30 and must be completed.b. If a student is absent only on the day when major assignments are due but has had the same opportunity to prepare as the other students, that student must be prepared to complete the work on the day he/she returns. If a conflict arises, this work may be completed at the discretion of the teacher.c. Students suspended from school, or having an unexcused absence, will be given the opportunity to make up assignments for partial credit.
