

Work Ethics Seal Program

History and Purpose: Bath County High School is proud to be part of the regional work ethics seal program since its beginnings in 2006. The mission of this program is to teach students about the importance of exhibiting great work ethic in all endeavors they encounter while also providing students with necessary skills for the transition from school to work and life beyond high school.

This program began as a collaborative effort among the local businesses, industry, and school systems in the counties of Bath, Montgomery, and Menifee counties headed by the Montgomery Chamber of Commerce. This program was designed to provide a curriculum with the focus of instilling and clarifying the skills necessary to secure and maintain successful, meaningful employment. This year Bath County High School will be leading our own program. We will continue to adhere to the mission and purpose in which the Work Ethics Seal program was created.

Program Guidelines: Students wishing to participate in this program must meet the following minimum standards during their senior year:

- maintain an average daily attendance of 95%;
- accumulate no unexcused absences;
- accumulate no unexcused tardies;
- have no major disciplinary referrals;
- maintain a 2.5 GPA with no failures (no F's in classes);
- attend and successfully complete 4 seminars regarding work ethic;
- participate in seven hours of job shadowing (recommended but not required); and
- be involved in at least 2 of the following
 - an organized team sport,
 - an organized non-team sport,
 - an extracurricular programs,
 - a part-time employment.

Scholarship Guidelines: Students participating in the work ethics seal program are eligible to apply for the Morehead State Work Ethics Seal Scholarship. Students must complete the following:
